- Our own working groups in the fields of breast cancer, ovarian cancer, cervix cancer, endometrium cancer, as well as supporting therapies, translational research and global health.





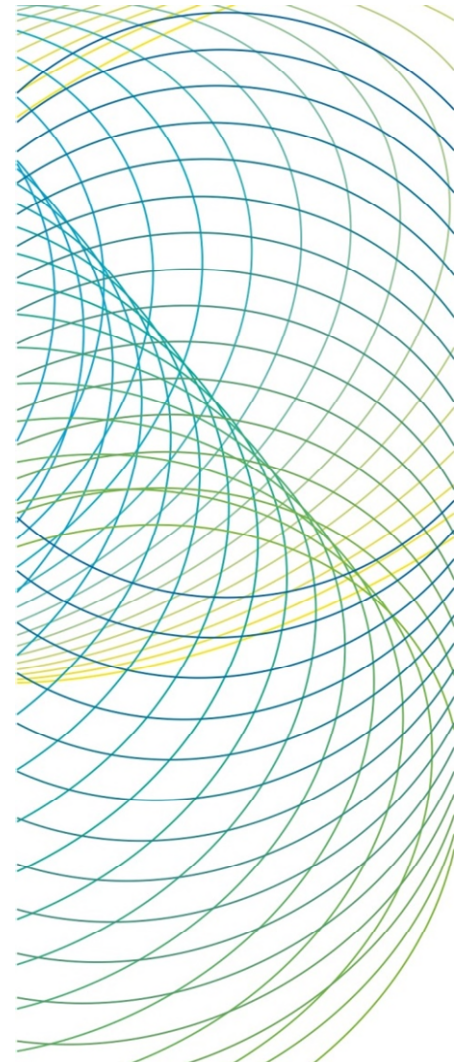
# Quality of association

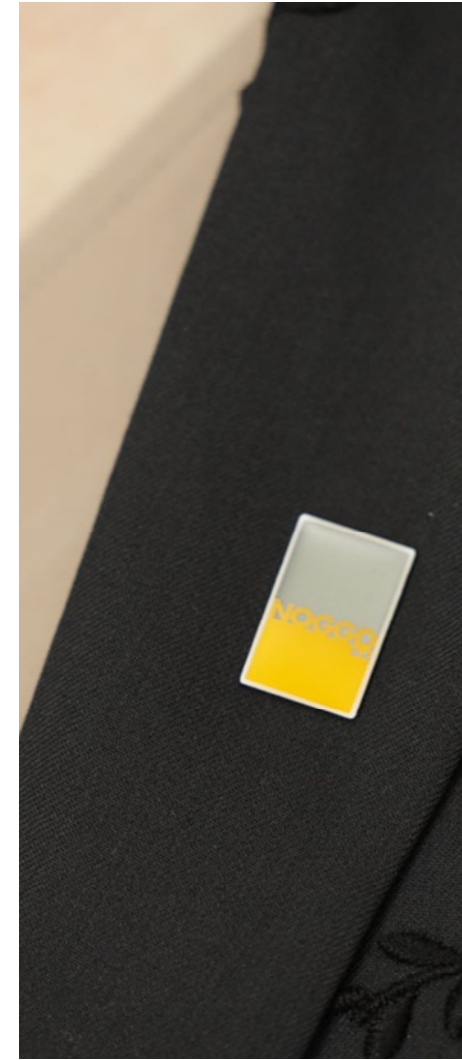

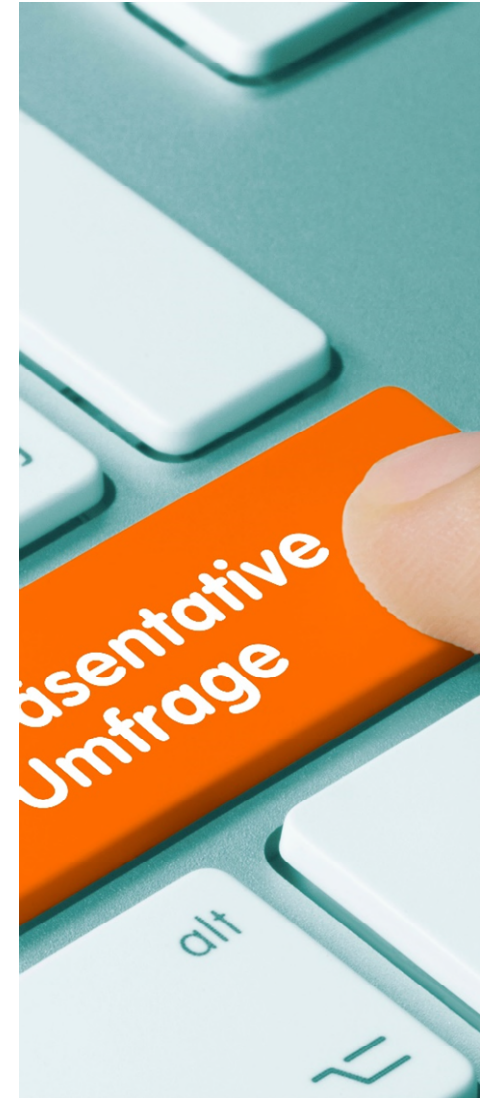

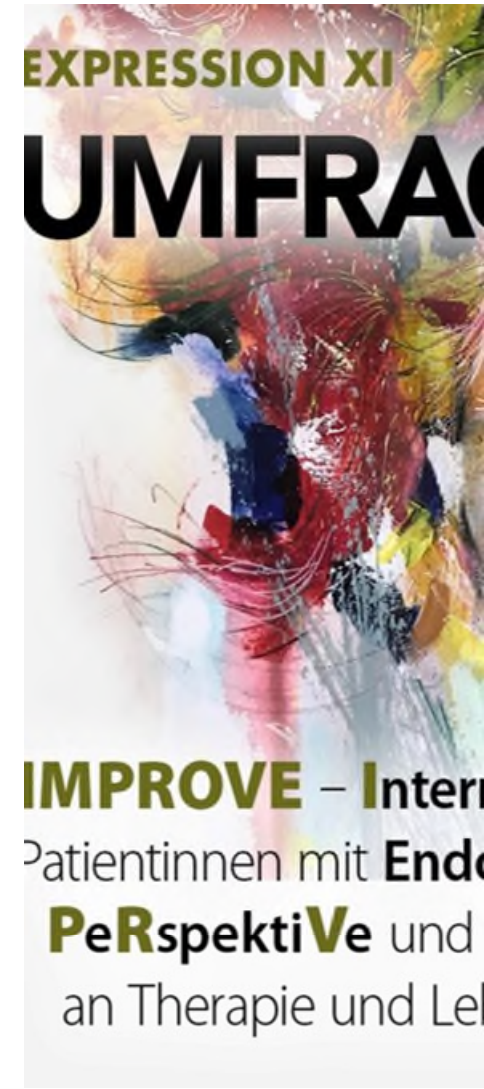
